DROP SHOT FISHING **WAS THE SUBJECT** OF THE DAY



PFBC BOARD GIVES PRELIMINARY APPROVAL TO PROPOSED FEE ADJUSTMENTS NECESSARY TO DELIVER QUALITY FISHING AND BOATING

HARRISBURG, Pa. (March 1, 2023) – During a special meeting held today, the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC) Board of Commissioners gave preliminary approval to a list of proposed fee adjustments for various fishing licenses and permits for the 2024 license year.

"Through these modest fee adjustments, we are keeping pace with the rising costs associated with maintaining vital infrastructure, services, and programs that anglers and boaters deserve and have come to expect," said Robert BJ Small, PFBC President and District 6 Commissioner. "Our goal is to keep the prices of fishing licenses and permits as low as possible, while still being able to upgrade and invest in the equipment, staff, programs, and facilities, such as our fish hatcheries and hundreds of public access areas, that deliver quality recreation throughout the Commonwealth. Adjusting fees to match our business needs, when necessary, will ensure that Pennsylvania remains a destination for fishing and boating for a very long time."

Under the proposal, the price of the most common fishing license and permits, a Resident Annual Fishing License, Trout Permit, and Combination Trout/Lake Erie Permit, would increase by \$2.50 each in 2024. Separate increases would be applied to other license and permit categories for non-residents, seniors, and tourists. If approved, revenues from these fee increases are expected to generate an estimated \$2.9 million annually for the PFBC's Fish Fund to support fishing related programs.

In accordance with Act 56 of 2020, which provided the PFBC with the authorization to set fees, the proposed fee adjustments must be given preliminary approval by the Board, be presented during a public hearing, and given final approval by the Board. Also, in accordance with Act 56, after final Board approval, the fee adjustments will be shared with the Pennsylvania House and Senate Game and Fisheries Committees for their review.

The date for the public hearing has yet to be established and is expected to be announced.

In Memoriam

3-CU Founding Member Bob Hetz passed away on February 24th, 2023 Bob spent most of his adult life in service to the Lake Erie fishery. Bob was one of the founding members of the3-CU Trout Club which was organized in 1966. 3-CU was the name developed for the 3 clubs that sponsored its organization. They were the Gem City Outdoorsmen, Erie County Sportsmen's Club and the Wesleyville Conservation Club. We think that Bob was one of the last of the surviving charter members.

For 67 years bob dedicated his life to raising trout for distribution into the Lake Erie tributary streams. During that time millions of fish were stocked.

Bob has been recognized for his efforts with 3-C-U numerous times, probably too many to recall but we will list a few.

In 2012 Bob was awarded the prestigious Ralph W. Abele Conservation Heritage Award by the Game and Fisheries Committee of the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on October 18, 2012.

The Ralph W. Abele Award is the highest recognition awarded by the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC) to a Pennsylvania citizen who has made outstanding contributions to the conservation and enhancement of Pennsylvania's aquatic resources

At the Pennsylvania Steelhead Associations 2016 Fall Run Banquet held at Crowley's Restaurant Bob Hetz of 3-C-U was honored for his efforts during 50 years of raising millions of fish (Steelhead, Browns, and Brookies) for our local waters, and maintaining 4 and 5 raceways at a time. He received a beautiful Steelhead and Brown Trout Nature Table made by local artist John Ballard of Ballard Woods in Northeast, PA. It was well deserved and long overdue!

In the spring of 2021 the Pennsylvania Outdoor News honored Bob as the 2020 Person of the Year in honor of his 50+ years of dedication to the Erie Fishery.

Bob's dedicated efforts have contributed significantly to making "Steelhead Alley" in Erie County, Pennsylvania one of the world's premiere Steelhead fisheries. The Pennsylvania Steelhead Association joins other appreciative anglers and sportsmen in offering condolences to the Hetz family.

NORTH EAST MARINA IN NEED OF REPAIRS

PA Fish & Boat Commission Shuts Down Electrical Services at North East Marina

The PA Fish & Boat Commission has shut down the North East Marina's electrical service indefinitely due to the system needing replacement.

In fall 2022, it was discovered that the marina's electrical system had damaged wires, and the system itself is too old to repair. All electrical service has since been removed from the docks.

The Commission was informed that repairs would require a completely new electrical system and "extensive infrastructure upgrades" to meet modern building code requirements.

Due to supply chain issues, materials necessary for the upgrade are currently unavailable.

The PA Fish & Boat Commission is currently assessing the possibilities of upgrading the electrical system of the marina.

The marina itself will remain open for boating and docking.

We also learned that since this story was posted that there also are some issues regarding the dredging permits that the PFBC has to keep the channel into the marina open. The permits are issued by the PA DEP and the Army Corps of Engineers. We will keep you posted as we learn more.


