FISHING REPORT:

Frequent rains during October turned on the steelhead run, but put a damper on other types of fishing. Face book however still exhibited some nice walleye and perch being caught. Walleye are still being caught as shown by these photos posted by East End Angler on their Facebook page.

Both men brought in these fish to be weighed at East End Angler as their entries in the Blaster Products Walleye Fall Brawl tournament. On Saturday November 8th I made my daily check of our Trout Run and Walnut Creek web cams. The Trout Run Camera showed heavy surf and no fishermen. The Walnut Creek camera recorded over a 100 fishermen trying their luck fishing off the channel walls, boat launch, and boat basin.

OUR WEB CAMERAS ATTRACT THOUSANDS OF VIEWERS

In September 2021 the SONS of Lake Erie partnered with Fairview Township, Fish USA, and the PA Steelhead Assoc. installed a web cam at the mouth of Trout Run at Avonia Beach in Fairview, PA. Since then 100's of thousands of visitors have visited the sight. In October 2025 there were 135,083 views by 68,145 unique viewers. WOW!

We also partnered with the PA Fish Commission and Fish USA and installed another camera at the Walnut Creek Access area in December 2023. It is popular year around and October 2025 it drew 68,349 views by 38,901 visitors. We have another camera at Lampe Marina in partnership with the Erie Western PA Port Authority and Fish USA. It had 8,301 views by 4,738 viewers.





2025-26 HATCHERY SEASON KICKED OFF

The 2025-26 hatchery season kicked off on Thursday November 6, 2025 when a truck from PFBC's Linesville Fish Culture Station. The driver brought with him 750 brown trout for us to raise in our hatchery at the foot of Chestnut Street in Erie. This was half of our 1500 allotment as part of the PFBC's Co Operative

program. The balance of 750 brown trout will be delivered on November 13th. The local TV stations were on hand to record the event. The fish will be cared for by our hatchery crew, led by our Hatchery Manager Jack Bock with a host of volunteers until late March, when they will be stocked into Presque Isle Bay.





LANDMARK RESTORATION COMPLETED

In 2017, restoration of a landmark steel intake gear tower that is located at Presque Isle State Park was commenced. The 37' steel tower resembles a lighthouse. It housed an emergency shutoff gear for the city's water supply. The work was financed from a grant by former Erie natives Dan and Sallie Shipley. Work was completed with the help of Alex Roofing Co, Lake Shore towing, Rog's Crane Service. Don Jon Shipbuilding Lake Shore Towing and many more. SONS frequent volunteer Ray Halt acted as Project Manager. Solar powered lighting was recently completed to finish the project. It looks great.



LAKE LEVELS ARE NEARLY BACK TO NORMAL

In 2018 the water level in the Great Lakes rose to a high of 5 ft. above normal in June/ July of 2019 on Oct . 29, 2025 the level was down to .5 of a foot as demonstrated in the photos below.

OHIO DNR REPORTS SUMMARY OF FALL SURVEY RESULTS

Hatch Results: The Ohio Division of Wildlife has reported that the 2025 walleye hatch has been designated as "Exceptional," which suggests a high probability of around 20 million young walleye entering the fishery by 2027. This is significant as walleye typically reach the legal keeper length of 15 inches by their third summer.

Current Fishing Conditions: As of October 2025, walleye anglers are experiencing good fishing conditions in Lake Erie. Reports indicate successful catches while trolling in deeper waters, with average sizes of kept walleye ranging from 16 to 22 inches, and some larger specimens reaching 23 to 27 inches. The daily limit for walleye remains at six fish per angler, with a minimum size requirement of 15 inches.

Future Expectations: The strong hatch in 2025 follows several years of above-average hatches, which should contribute positively to the walleye population in the coming years. Anglers can expect a variety of sizes, including younger fish that will grow into the catchable size range as the season progresses.

Summary: The fall 2025 walleye survey indicates a robust population due to the exceptional hatch, promising good fishing opportunities for anglers in Ohio. The combination of favorable conditions and a healthy walleye population suggests that the fishing season will be productive, with expectations for continued success in the coming years.



REMINDER: EXTENDED TROUT SEASON REGULATIONS

Trout anglers can take advantage of the Extended Trout Season which began on September 2, 2025, and lasts through February 16, 2026. During the extended season, the daily creel limit is three trout of combined species with a minimum size of seven inches, unless the water is managed under special regulations. Extended Trout Season regulations apply only to designated Stocked Trout Waters, and harvest of trout in other waters during the extended trout season is prohibited.



SPAWNING SHACK IN PLACE AT AVONIA BEACH

The PFBC recently placed a portable building on the beach at the mouth of Trout Run in preparation to remove eggs and spawn that will be collected from the steelhead that are gathered in the stream, Egg Harvest at Trout Run will begin on Tuesday, December 2nd. The time is 8 AM.

BOATING THIS FALL? WEAR IT!

From November 1 through April 30, anyone on a boat less than 16 feet in length, including all canoes, kayaks, and paddleboards, is required to wear a life jacket. Children ages 12 and under must always wear a life jacket while paddling.
